GRADE ENTERING:

PRE-SCHOOL

We request that you read to your child 10-15 minutes every day.

PRE-KINDERGARTEN

We request that you read to your child 10-15 minutes every day.

KINDERGARTEN

We request that you read to your child 10-15 minutes every day. Please see attached Kindergarten Summer Reading Page.

GRADE 1

We request that you read to your child or your child reads to you 15-20 minutes every day.

- Review all consonant and short vowel sounds
- Review digraphs /sh/, /th/, /ch/, /ing/
- Practice reading and writing sight words (see attached)

*If your child can read all of the sight words on the list automatically (under 3 seconds each), email Mrs.

Hersey (vhersey@saintpatrickacademy.org) for some 1st grade sight words to practice

- Practice addition/subtraction facts up to 10

- Practice writing uppercase/lowercase letters and numbers up to 30 correctly (top to bottom)

GRADE 2

We request that your child read 3 chapter books appropriate to his/her reading level. (Ex. Henry and Mudge series, Young Cam Jansen series, Nate the Great series, Frog and Toad series, Mercy Watson series, Mr. Putter and Tabby series, Amelia Bedelia series, or any other age-appropriate ones that your child is interested in)

Study addition and subtraction combinations from 0-20. Practice value of coins.

GRADE 3

Freckle Juice by Judy Blume

... and any other 2 age-appropriate chapter books

Review addition and subtraction facts (with carrying and borrowing) and multiplication tables 0-5. Complete math packet from Mrs. Frazier.

GRADE 4

Reading: Three age-appropriate chapter books; please be ready to write a short report on each book.

Math: Rocket math; please see the attached copies and instructions.
