



St. Pat's SPOTLIGHT

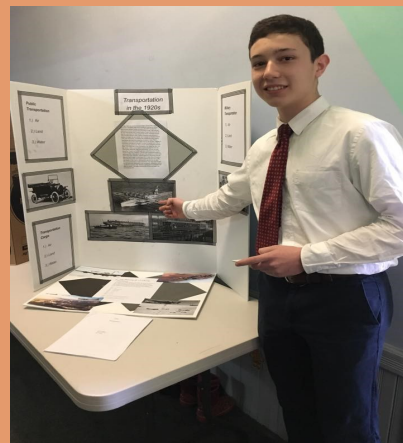
