

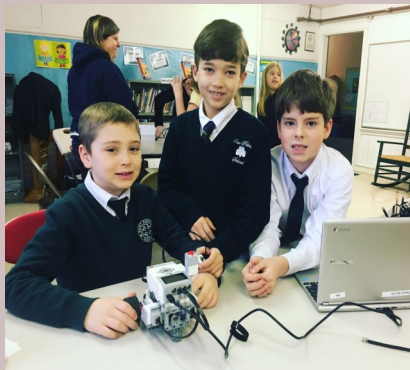


The Academy SPOTLIGHT
