Our Response to the Coronavirus Pandemic

Our team of dedicated educators made timely and effective adjustments to our previous and current school year, keeping students engaged, learning, and safe.

- ✚ Successfully made the transition to remote learning and continued live, synchronous instruction through the end of the 2019-2020 school year with continued academic success.

During Stay-At-Home orders we:

- ✚ Provided virtual tours.
- ✚ Held weekly all-school assemblies via Zoom.
- ✚ Live-streamed Mass weekly throughout the month of May from the Our Lady Seat of Wisdom Chapel.
- ✚ Published a daily e-Newsletter, The Shamrock Snapshot, including a student-led prayer, the Pledge of Allegiance, and a daily message and challenge from the Head of School.

Preparing for the 2020-2021 School Year we:

- ✚ Created a Task Force for reopening the School.
- ✚ Developed remote learning plans for each division.
- ✚ Added an additional 48 Chromebooks to our supply.
- ✚ Completed a technology plan that creates a replacement cycle for hardware.
- ✚ Upgraded our HVAC system with Merv-13 filtration and continuous air programming.
- ✚ De-densified indoor classrooms and created outdoor learning spaces.
- ✚ Invested in hydrostatic spray cleaners.

Faith Education

- ✚ Implemented a weekly Lower School Prayer.
- ✚ Offered confession during Lent and invited three priests representing three local parishes.
- ✚ Focused on the virtue of Justice and its accompanying virtues.
- ✚ Hosted weekly Mass for entire school community.

Extra-Curricular

- ✚ Added a volleyball program to our Fall Athletics offerings.
- ✚ Launched a successful summer program despite COVID-19 challenges.
 - 267 participants registered in all programs.
 - \$55,280 in new income.
 - 63 families participated, 52 of which were SPA families.

Anchored on the truths of the Catholic Faith, Saint Patrick Academy's mission sets us apart. At Saint Patrick Academy, children come to see that they are made in the image and likeness of a God who LOVES them. 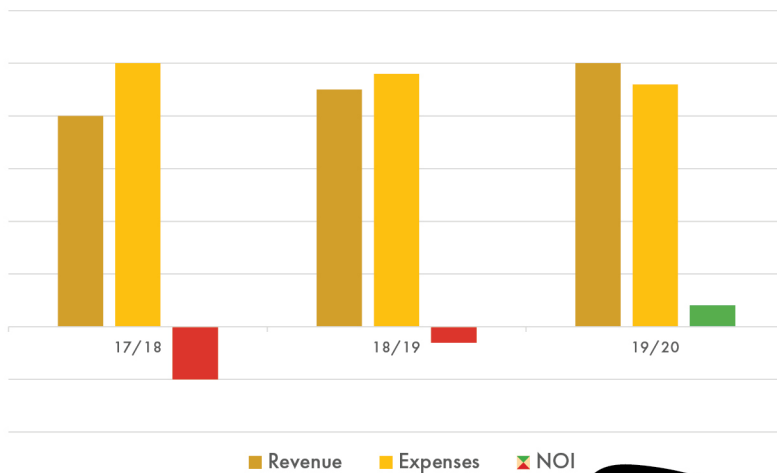
